



Speed Sentry Sign Capabilities

As part of the Hunterdon County Safe Routes to School Program, HART is making available a radar speed sign for use by Hunterdon County schools and municipalities. The sign is available for loan, free of charge, for up to one month at a time.



These signs, which are used throughout the State, serve two primary purposes:

1. To make motorists aware of their speed, encouraging them to slow to the posted limit
2. To collect data on actual travel speeds along a particular roadway. HART will provide a speed data report after each loan. A sample report is available at tiny.cc/SS-Bloomsbury (case sensitive).

Features:

- Senses and displays oncoming vehicle speed
- Records speed data for more than 30 days
- Identifies peak volume and violation periods
- Stealth Mode - Radar and data recording with the display deactivated. This provides a better record of typical speeds.
- Options for flashing digits and/or a strobe light which activates if the driver is above the limit
- Mounts to an existing road sign post or telephone pole
- Powered independently by a solar panel
